- Buz** by Richard Egielski P
When a little boy swallows a bug along with his cereal, pandemonium breaks out as the bug searches for an escape, the boy searches for an antidote, and the pills search for the bug.
- Creepy Crawly Calypso** by Tony Langham E
Ten kinds of spiders and insects use a variety of instruments to make calypso music.
- Cucumber Soup** by Vickie Leigh Krudwig P
All the insects in the garden get involved in moving a fallen cucumber.
- Diary of a Fly** by Doreen Cronin P
